

# *Potential Odor Advisory – Countywide Recycling and Disposal Facility*

## Potential Odor Advisory - Operations, Monitoring, and Maintenance Plan Required Activities

**DETAILS:** The Countywide facility would like to inform its neighbors about potential odor. Certain monitoring and maintenance activities required by the Operations, Monitoring, and Maintenance Plan have the potential to generate odor. These activities are necessary to maintain the effectiveness of the leachate collection system and monitor the affects of the reaction. As a result, there may be short periods resulting in odor. **This work will occur during the final week of February but will avoid the weekends.** As always, every attempt and precaution will be taken to minimize the duration and strength of odors, if they occur.

Overall, odor has been reduced at Countywide since the Summer of 2009 completion of additional temporary capping work and enhancements to the landfill's gas extraction system. These enhancements continue to assist Countywide's efforts to eliminate odor and effectively manage the byproducts of the reaction.
